





INSTALLATION

Assemble the vacuum lifter as directed in the "ASSEMBLY" section of the lifter's *OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS*. Then install Pad Frame Extension Arms where required to provide optimal load support:

Do not use Extension Arms to increase long dimension of pad frame (see drawing on page 3).

- 1) Remove the hardware that secures a pad mount to a pad frame tube. 1
- 2) Remove the pad mount and the end plug from the pad frame tube.
- 3) Slide the end of an <u>extension arm</u> over the pad frame tube:
 - For lifters manufactured after April 1, 2014, the holes nearest to the end of the extension arm straps should align with holes in the tube; fig. 3A shows the provided hardware installed in these holes.

- For lifters manufactured before April 1, 2014, the holes farthest from the end of the straps should align with holes in the tube.
- 4) Install the provided hardware in the aligned holes, to secure the extension arm to the pad frame tube. Make sure to tighten the hardware securely.
- 5) Position the pad mount on the extension arm, aligning the holes in the pad mount with the corresponding holes in the extension arm. Then reinstall the removed hardware.²
- 6) Repeat steps 1-5 to install other extension arms as needed to provide optimal support across the load surface and to minimize load overhang.

^{1.....} If the hardware is composed of a bolt, washers and a nut, note the order of these components for reinstallation. If the pad mount is secured by a cotterless hitch pin, simply remove the pin.

^{2.....} If the hardware is composed of a bolt, washers and a nut, make sure to tighten the hardware securely. Otherwise, simply reinstall the cotterless hitch pin to secure the pad mount.
