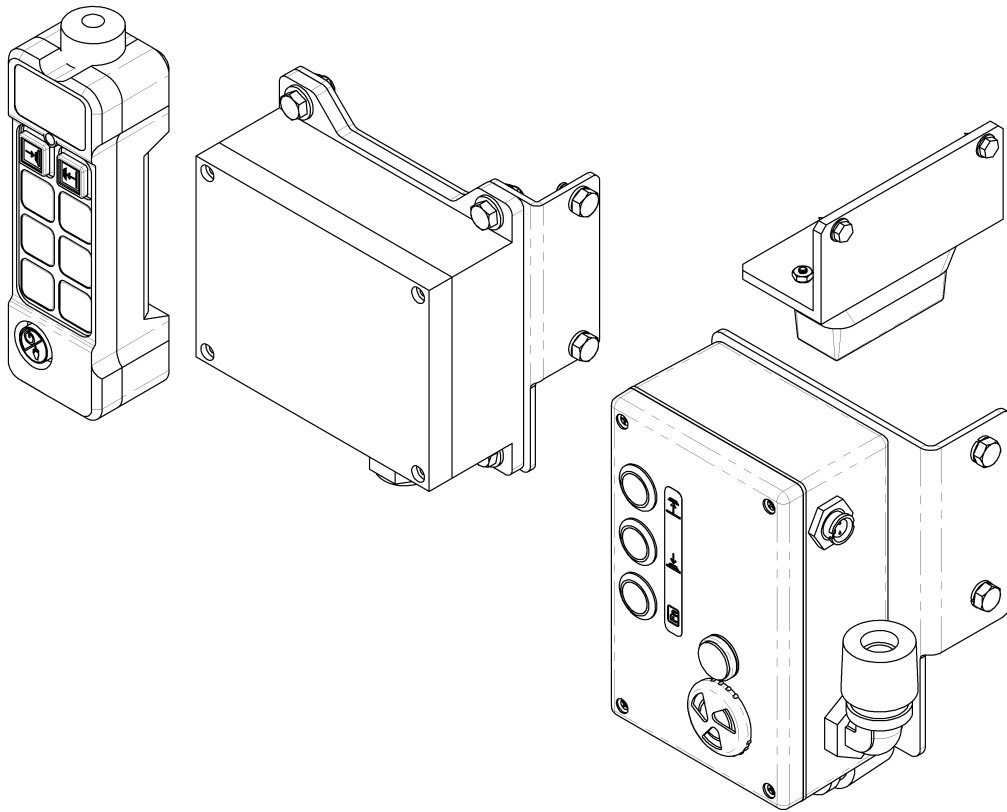

INSTALLATION

⚠ WARNING: *Read all instructions before attempting to retrofit lifter with radio control option.*

Tools

- 1) 5/16" open-end or socket wrench
- 2) 7/16" open-end or socket wrench

Disassembly

Note: See the OPERATING FEATURES in the MR1611LDC lifter's instruction manual to identify any features not clearly shown in the illustrations to follow.

- 1) Support the lifter as directed in the OPERATION section of MR1611LDC lifter's instruction manual (see AFTER USING THE LIFTER).
- 2) Disconnect the electrical connectors uniting the battery to the battery charger and the vacuum generating system.
- 3) Disconnect the movable control pendant from the lifter and store the pendant in a clean, dry location to protect it from environmental exposure.

Assembly¹

- 1) Mount the radio receiver by its mounting bracket using a 7/16" wrench and fasteners supplied, as indicated in Figures 1 and 2.
- 2) Mount the control enclosure assembly by its mounting bracket using a 7/16" wrench and fasteners supplied, as indicated in Figures 1 and 2.
- 3) Mount the strobe light by its mounting bracket using a 5/16" wrench and the 10-16 x 1/2" self-tapping screws supplied, as indicated in Figures 1 and 2.

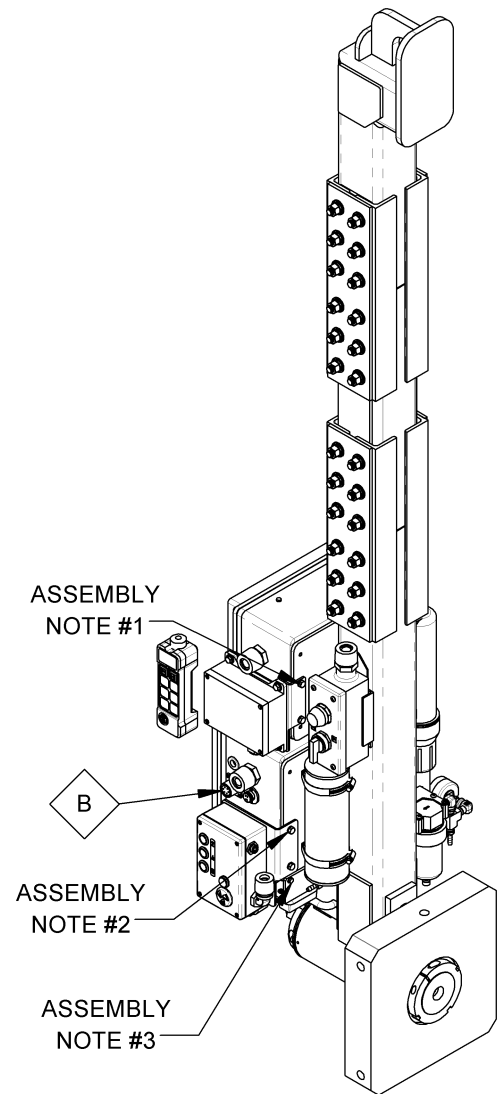

¹ Older lifters may not have predrilled holes where indicated. If not, you can use each mounting bracket as a template to mark and drill appropriately sized holes for the fasteners supplied.

- 4) Connect the electrical connector between the strobe light and control enclosure assembly, as indicated by Tags A in Figure 2.
- 5) Connect the electrical connector between the radio receiver and control enclosure assembly, as indicated by Tags C in Figure 2.
- 6) Connect the electrical connector between the control enclosure assembly and the appropriate receptacle on the power system enclosure, as indicated by Tags B in Figures 1 and 2.
- 7) Use zip-ties supplied (WPG stock #15752) to secure excess cord and make sure that electrical cords will not be damaged or severed during lifter use, handling or storage.
- 8) Connect the electrical connectors uniting the battery to the battery charger and the vacuum generating system.
- 9) Perform a VACUUM TEST of the lifter, as well as all other Operational and Load Tests, as directed in MAINTENANCE: TESTING SCHEDULE of the MR1611LDC lifter's instruction manual. Also see the lifter's instruction manual for SPECIFICATIONS and OPERATION instructions.

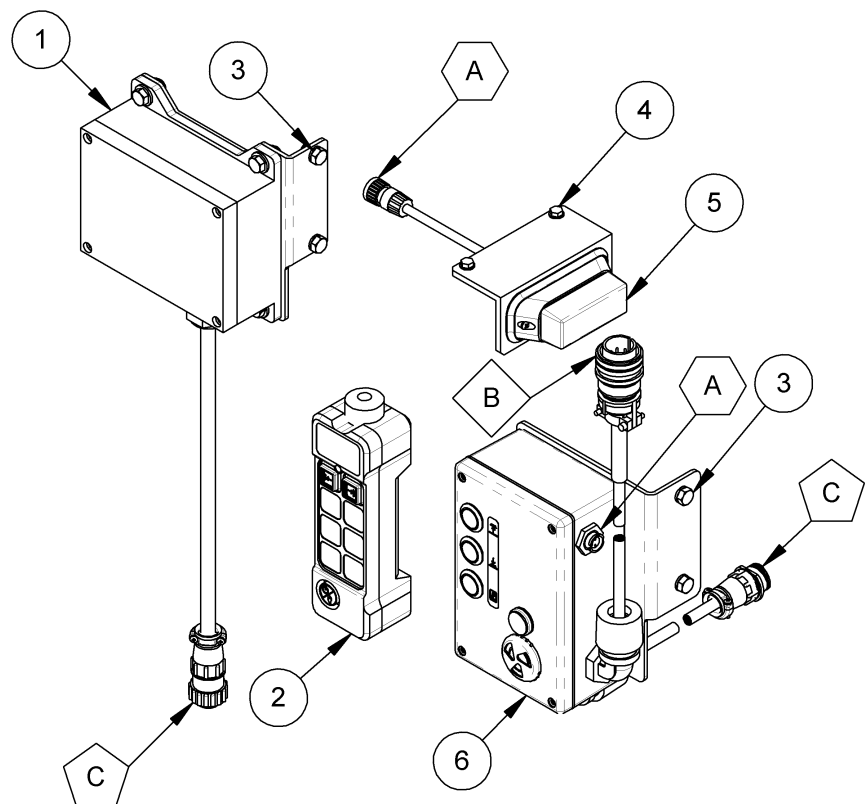

- 1) RADIO RECEIVER W/MOUNTING BRACKET
- 2) RADIO TRANSMITTER
- 3) 1/4-20 x 1/2" HEX HEAD BOLT & 1/4" SPLIT LOCK WASHER
- 4) 10-16 x 1/2" SELF-TAPPING SCREW
- 5) STROBE LIGHT W/MOUNTING BRACKET
- 6) CONTROL ENCLOSURE ASSEMBLY W/MOUNTING BRACKET

LIMITED WARRANTY

Modifications have been made to the product after leaving the factory.

Rubber portions have been cut or scratched during use.

Repairs are required due to abnormal wear and tear.

The product has been damaged, misused, or neglected.

If a problem is not covered under warranty, Powr-Grip will notify the customer of costs prior to repair. If the customer agrees to pay all repair costs and to receive the repaired product on a C.O.D. basis, Powr-Grip then will proceed with repairs.
