ROTARY VANE PUMP CONVERSION KIT

INSTALLATION

Note: Before installing the Rotary Vane Pump Conversion Kit read, understand and follow the lifter's OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS except when directed differently in this INSTRUCTIONS MANUAL. Specifications, intended use, storage, inspections, tests and maintenance in the lifter's instructions should be understood to include components of this kit, when relevant. All warnings in the "SAFETY" section, as well as alerts in other sections, are applicable when installing the Rotary Vane Pump Conversion Kit.

TO MOUNT THE PUMP

- 1) Place the lifter's power switch in the "off" position (()). Disconnect the lifter's power cable from the power source.
- 2) Disconnect the power cable from the existing pump.
- 3) Remove the existing vacuum pump, including the mounting plate.
- Attach the new pump and its attached mounting plate (fig. 3A) securely using the supplied hardware.

Note: Plate and hardware will differ, depending on the kit (see "REPLACEMENT PARTS" on page 5).

Note: Different screws may be required, depending on the age and model of the lifter.



INSTALLATION

TO WIRE THE PUMP



Wiring should be performed by qualified service personnel.

 Determine whether the wires provided are long enough to reach the lifter's power enclosure. If not, add additional wire to the vacuum pump's wiring harness.

Note: Any wire added must be 16 AWG or greater.


- 2) Route the wiring harness, to avoid damage or interference with any moving parts of the lifter.
- 3) Wire the pump to the lifter using the wiring diagram provided in the final section of these instructions.


To Connect the Vacuum Hoses

Note: The Rotary Vane Pump Conversion Kit ships with the hose fittings attached to the pump.

Note: Ports are identified on the pump.

- Connect the hoses leading from the exhaust port to the lifter's control valve exhaust port (fig. 1B). Then secure it with the supplied hose clamp.
- 2) Similarly, connect the hoses leading from the vacuum port to the lifter's control valve
 - to the lifter's control valve vacuum port. Then secure it with the supplied hose clamp.

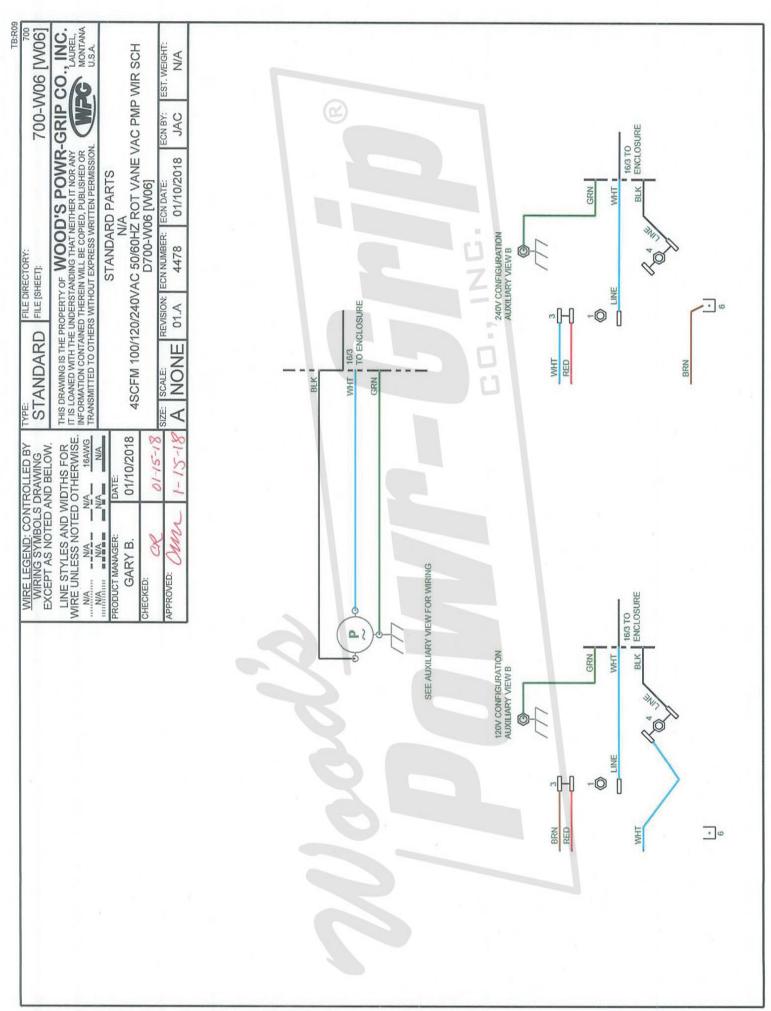
